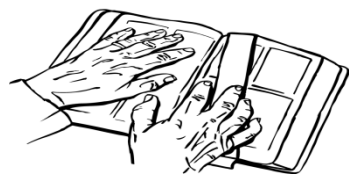

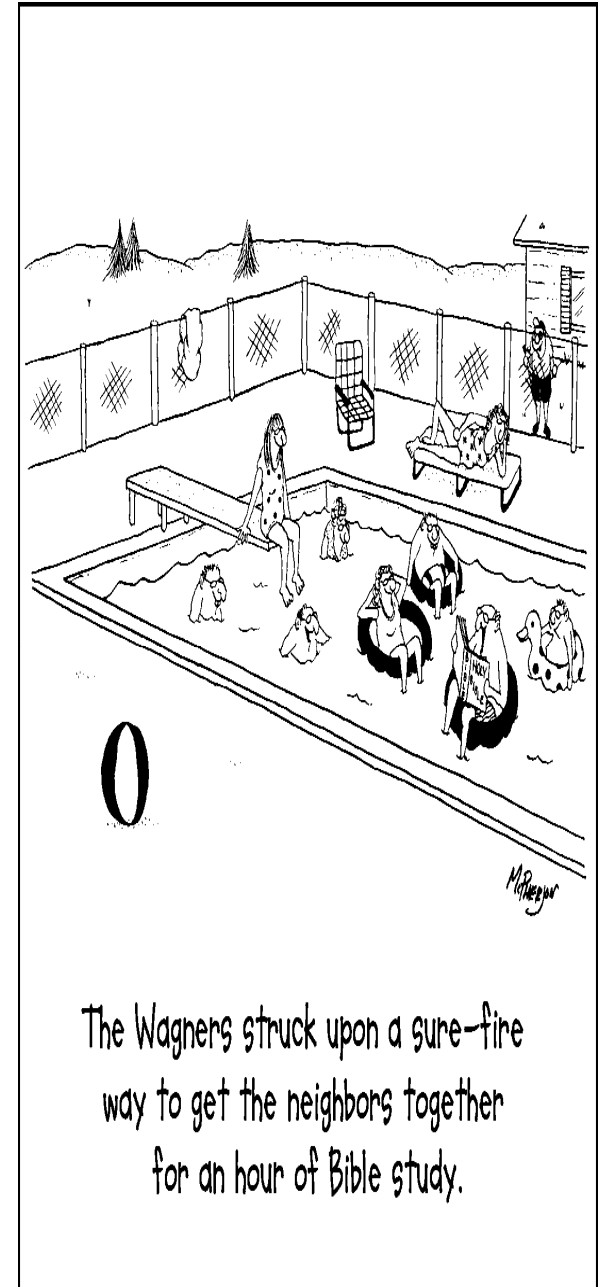
SUMMER OUTREACH
